Dear Parents/Carers,

This week in phonics, we have been learning the letter sounds **i and n**

Please spend a little time at home revising these sounds with your child. Can they:

- Recognise each of the letters **i and n**?
- Say the correct sound when they see each letter?
- Remember and perform the **action** for each sound?

Fun ways to practise at home

You could write the letters **i and n** on Post-it Notes or small pieces of paper and stick them around the house in places your child will see regularly — for example, on the **bathroom mirror, fridge, doors or on the way up the stairs**. Each time they spot a letter, encourage them to say the sound and do the action.

You can also make it into a little **sound hunt** when you are out and about. Look for **i and n** on signs, shop names, food packets, posters and other print you see.

Remember, just a few minutes of practice each day can make a big difference. Most importantly, keep it **fun and encouraging!** ✨

n

Weave one finger across like a needle. Say nnn.
